The Maine Baseball Hall of Fame was founded in 1969 to celebrate the game, honor its pioneers, and preserve its memories and legacies.

In 1988, a committee of the HOF was formed to set up scholarships to honor several deserving senior high school baseball players, and several deserving senior high school softball players. The boy scholarships would honor Edward J. "Packy" McFarland, legendary Scarborough baseball, and basketball coach, and athletic director.

The girl scholarships would honor Marie Noel, the beloved late wife of larger-than-life figure Wilfred "Sonny" Noel, General Chairman of the Maine Baseball Hall of Fame. Sonny was a parachute commander at D-Day, Omaha Beach, Normandy, France, on June 6, 1944, and later went on to a national umpiring career, the highlight of which might have been being assigned Home Plate Umpire at the College World Series on three occasions in the 1960s and 70s.

The HOF seeks in 2021 to undertake fundraising to increase the number of scholarships, and the stability of the fund. Our first step will be to offer "donor rewards" for contributions to the scholarship fund. An HOF benefactor has transferred a large collection of vintage 1960s-70s-80s sports books and magazines to us. We will be utilizing those gems in our fundraising campaign.
